
Hello Michel,

If i load this route in my android handy and say navigate, Sygic not runs correct. There only drive a circle course around the nears streets on my start point.




Yestday I try the same route. After input a third waypoint in the middle i can navigate. On the way Sygic says after reaching on the waypoint (in the middle of the route) target reached.


That's stupid and not my target!!
